Parent Questionnaire Results

A huge thank you to everyone who completed the questionnaire. Here, we will be sharing the results with you and our subsequent actions.

We received 9 responses from families of children attending Pitton CE Primary School. The questionnaire consisted of 17 questions. Actions to be taken by the school

- **Tea on the Playground** – In order for parents to meet school governors and have more information on the members of the Local Governance Committee (LGC) we will continue to hold a joint event with FOPs and Governors and have 'Tea on The Playground' 3 times a year. This will give parents an opportunity to meet governors and talk to them about their role. The Autumn term date will be announced in the Pitton News shortly.

- **Governor Information** – Information regarding the governors is available on the school website. This information, including photographs so they are easily recognisable, will support the ‘Tea on The Playground’ and Open Morning events throughout the year. This will ensure parents know who the governors are, their role, their responsibilities and how they can be contacted. - **Open Morning and Curriculum Afternoons** – Parents are invited to attend Open Mornings and Curriculum Open Afternoons. Last academic year there were 2 curriculum afternoons and we aim to continue these events this year. During Curriculum Afternoons you also have the opportunity to share your child’s books and current learning with your child.
- **Parent Consultations** – Parents will be invited to Parent Consultations WB 21st November 2022. Parent Consultations happen twice a year with an end of year report shared in July. At these consultations parents will be given the results of any assessments, current attainment and recommendations on how to support their child’s learning at home. If you have any concerns or wish to discuss progress with your child’s class teacher we ask that you contact admin@pitton.wilts.sch.uk or use the messaging system on Class Dojo.
- **Clubs** – September 2022 will see the return of a range of after school clubs on every weekday. There are currently the following clubs on offer to pupils: KS1 dance, KS2 dance, Choir, Recording, Netball, Football, KS1 gym club, KS2 sport club and Eco Club. Information regarding signing up is available on ParentMail. In school music lessons will also return including saxophone, clarinet, guitar, ukulele and piano.

We hope you find these results informative and interesting to read. Again, I would like to thank all those parents and carers who took the time to complete the questionnaire, for your support for our school and providing suggestions for areas to develop.
