School Car Park

A reminder that the school car park, due to it's size, is for staff only. Please utilize the surrounding roads for parking and remember the one-way system for Above Hedges, as well as not parking in allocated spaces for houses.

Driving To & From School

- We strongly encourage an informal one-way system at drop-off and collection time, to keep congestion in the roads around the school to a minimum., using Black Lane as an entry and Above Hedges as an exit.
- Please observe the yellow zig-zag lines and for everyone's safety, please also avoid parking right on the junction opposite or adjacent to the entrance – the  points on the map. Vehicles parked in these places severely restrict visibility at the school entrance and we have had some near misses.
- Please refrain from turning in the road or at the junctions as these actions increase the likelihood of an accident. Please also refrain from turning in the driveways of our neighbours.
- Please do not leave any valuables in your car whilst in the school.
- Please do **not** park in the school car park, except in the winter when collecting after 4.30pm from ASAP.
