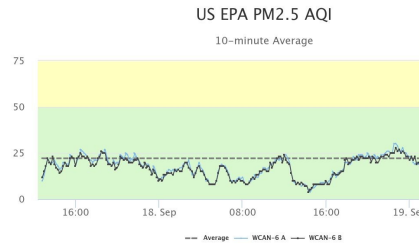

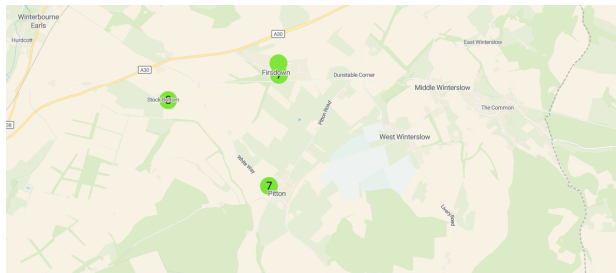
Air Pollution Monitoring
