UNICEF is the world's leading children's organization; it is an agency of the United Nations – meaning that their work is impartial and non-political. They work to improve the rights of children providing humanitarian and developmental aid to children worldwide, particularly the most vulnerable.

As part of Soccer Aid 2025, Pitton Primary is signed up to take part in three challenges; focusing on sporting skills, creativity and teamwork. We’ll be getting active, fundraising and learning about UNICEF’s work around the world.
