- We would like to remind families of the importance of ensuring that children do not watch age-restricted films, series, or online content. These restrictions exist to protect young viewers from themes, language, and imagery that are not suitable for their age group. We have recently become aware that some pupils are referencing content intended for older audiences, and this can lead to inappropriate conversations or worries among their peers. We kindly ask for your support in monitoring what your child watches at home and helping them access only age-appropriate material.
